CERT CII 'Fast Track' study programme

The GII, in collaboration with the CII in UK and the University of Gibraltar are launching a 'Fast Track' Cert CII programme in Gibraltar. Students will take three certificate units within a six month period enabling them to complete their qualification whilst being supported throughout their studies by a comprehensive package including;

- Study text with updates
- Two whole day face to face training sessions per subject
- RevisionMate online study support tailored to each unit, including study tips
- Access to student discussion forum's to learn with peers
- Access to a CII tutor/mentor to provide ongoing technical support and guidance
- Cost of Exam

In just less than 6 months, you will be fully CERT CII qualified, completing by the end March 2017.

The intention is to give students a 'Fast Track' in achieving the CII Certificate qualification and at the same time obtain a good grounding across the disciplines by them studying for IF1 Insurance, Legal and Regulatory (a compulsory unit), IF3 Insurance Underwriting process and IF4 Insurance Claims Handling Process.

Students who already hold one or more of these units can join the programme to finish their studies at a reduced rate. Likewise, if a student has already ordered the coursebook and/or booked an exam, they are still entitled to take advantage of the face to face training sessions at a reduced cost*.
